

RED HORSE TROPHY

The Red Horse Trophy was a gift from Knud Reimers, noted Swedish sailor, as a gift to the Chicago Yacht Club 22 Square Meter Fleet from the 22 Square Meter Fleet of Sweden.

The red horse is a traditional Swedish Christmas symbol of cheer and good will. From inception in 1953 though 1963 it was awarded to the winner of a series open only to those who had not placed in the first three in any prior race that year. In 1964 the series was opened to the entire fleet.
